That said, it feels like our tomatoes have just finally started to ripen and we really haven't maximized our tomato harvest. We planted about 1500 plants or so - and due to a cold late Spring and inclimate summer - our nightshades really held back. They prefer to ripen in the evenings in 70+ degree temps, which we've hardly had this year. From our perspective, Climate Change is a real thing!

That said, if we had known that this would be a cool-wet year - we might have tried to grow some of the spring and fall crops straight through - spinach, lettuces, kales, and more greens!
